PUBLIC EXPRESSION

The Commission welcomes participation in the Commission meetings. Comments shall be limited to matters under the jurisdiction of the Commission which are not on the posted agenda and which may have not already been considered by the Commission. The Commission limits testimony to matters not on the agenda to the three (3) minutes per person, and not more than ten (10) minutes for a particular subject. **No action will be taken.**

ADDITIONS TO AGENDA

The Brown Act identifies the following three situations in which a body is permitted to take action on a matter not contained on the posted agenda:

- (1) Pursuant to Section 54954.2(b)(1) the body may discuss a non-agenda item if, by majority vote, the body determines that the matter in question constitutes an emergency pursuant to Section 54956.5.
- (2) Pursuant to Section 54954.2(b)(2) the body may discuss non-agenda item when the body determines (by two-thirds of the total body, or by unanimous vote if less than two-thirds present) that there is a need for immediate action must have come to the attention of the body after the agenda had already been posted. This determination must be made by two-thirds of the total body, or by unanimous vote, if less than two-thirds are present.
8. (3) Pursuant to Section 54954.2(b)(3) when an item has been posted on an agenda for a prior meeting, the item may be continued to a subsequent meeting that is held within five days of the meeting for which the item was properly posted. Under these circumstances, the item need not be posted for the subsequent meeting.
