SAN FRANCISCO'S 42ND STREET MOON ANNOUNCES CAST AND CREATIVE TEAM FOR OPENING PRODUCTION OF THE 2018-2019 SEASON THE BEST LITTLE WHOREHOUSE IN TEXAS OCTOBER 3 - 21, 2018

SAN FRANCISCO, CA (September 5, 2018) - San Francisco's 42nd Street Moon (Daren A.C. Carollo and Daniel Thomas, Co-Executive Directors) has announced the full cast and creative team for the opening production of its 2018-2019 season, *THE BEST LITTLE WHOREHOUSE IN TEXAS* (nominated for seven Tony Awards). *THE BEST LITTLE WHOREHOUSE IN TEXAS* features a book by Larry L.
